THE JAWONIO DNA

- Created in 1947 by families with "special needs" children
- Expanded as an affiliate of Cerebral Palsy
 [°]Association of NY to provide services to individuals with developmental disabilities
- Currently provides lifespan services for more than 5,000 children and adults annually funded by multiple State "O's"
- Recovery model introduced with IPRT Program in 1994



PROS program begins with conversion of IPRT and Vocational Services participants in 2011

MERGING THE MISSIONS

- Residential and Day Program Services
 promote **Person-Centered Care** through the age span to individuals with
- ° developmental disabilities
- IPRT becomes the foundation of the PROS Person-Centered Recovery model
- The physical proximity of the two populations encourages the development of an integrative approach
