

- 24/7/365 short-term crisis respites that are home-like alternatives to hospital psychiatric ERs and inpatient units.
- Currently, there are 4 houses serving 6 New York Counties.
- **We have helped open 42 Crisis Respites using the Rose House model.**
- Saving healthcare system \$6.57+ million each year with our Rose Houses.
- Responding to 10,000+ Warm Line calls each year
