OMH Services that Include Psychiatric Rehabilitation for Adults

- Personalized Recovery Oriented Services (**PROS**)
- Community Oriented Recovery and Empowerment (**CORE**)/Behavioral Health Home and Community Based Services (**BH HCBS**)
- Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (**CCBHC**)
- Assertive Community Treatment (**ACT**)
- State Aid Funded Employment Services
- Individualized Placement and Support (**IPS**) - an employment model within Rehab programs
